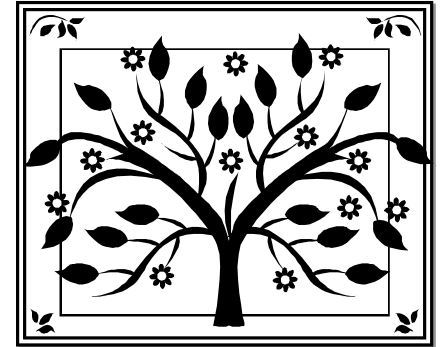
## Online Sources

- § **Ancestry Library Edition (In-library use only):** The library version of Ancestry.com contains more than 1.5 billion names in over 4,000 databases.
- § **HeritageQuest Online:** Includes census collection, genealogy and local history books, PERSI periodicals index, Revolutionary War Era Pension Records, and Freedman's Bank Records.
- § **Digital Sanborn Maps, 1867-1970:** Provides digital access to large-scale fire insurance maps of Colorado towns and cities.
